Pertinent weather information:

Winter Weather Advisory

- Today – A winter mix of snow with periods of rain and then becoming all snow this afternoon. Will begin to taper off this evening to snow showers and flurries. Could see flurries even into Wednesday.
- Temps. Today 30 – 34 degrees, but any precipitation could refreeze tonight as temperatures will be right at the freezing mark and become problematic Wed. AM.
- The temperatures will continue to get colder with **Sub-Freezing** Temperatures overnight Saturday Night.

Accumulation –

- North (Goldsboro and points north) 2 - 4 inches
- South 1 - 3 inches

Pertinent tide information:

- None

Recommended protective actions:

- Be careful on sidewalks and when exiting your vehicles.
- Most roadways will be mushy, please drive carefully.
- The snow will be wet and heavy, be cautious when shoveling, and take frequent breaks.
