

THE DEMOLITION OF *PLAIN DEALING*:
INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS REGARDING PROVISION OF
3,000 BRICKS TO SOCIETY

Provided for the Town of Denton by the Caroline County Historical Society

November 13, 2016

Bidders must provide 3,000 bricks to the Caroline County Historical Society. The Society plans to use the bricks as part of an exhibit in their museum in Denton. All other bricks are the property of the Bidder.

Specifications for the bricks to be supplied to the Society. The specified 3,000 bricks must be:

- (1) Whole bricks;
- (2) original to the structure (i.e., not from rebuilt sections of the building such as the lower portion of the north façade, the foundation of the woodframe addition, etc.);
- (3) free of paint;
- (4) of good quality (e.g., not interior “salmon” brick);
- (5) cleaned of mortar; and,
- (6) placed on pallets provided by the bidder
