Special Meeting

Mayor Branson called the meeting of the Denton Town Council to order at 6:10 PM on this date. Council members present included Councilmember Gregory, Councilmember Stockley and Mayor Branson.

Resolution #689 - *Brynja Booth, Town Attorney, was present and relayed the request made by the Caroline County Treasurer's Office had requested a resolution be adopted which reflects the Homestead Tax Credit percentage at 105%. Councilmember Gregory made a motion to adopt Resolution #680. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Stockley and so voted.*

The special meeting was closed at 6:16 p.m.

Working Session

A working session was opened at 6:16 p.m. Brynja Booth, Town Attorney, reviewed with the Council an option agreement with a one-year study period to evaluate a location for a water tower and well. This option agreement is between the Town of Denton and Choptank Electric. Any cost incurred for the construction of an elevated water tower and well proposed in the agreement would be at the developer's expense. The working session was closed at 6:53 p.m.
