The work includes, but is not limited to maintenance and protection of traffic, sawcutting, excavation, water main construction, fire hydrants, water services, valves and appurtenances, all required post-construction testing, trench restoration, temporary pavement restorations, concrete curbing, concrete sidewalk, concrete driveway aprons, concrete curb ramp, landscaping and permanent pavement restorations.
