**Town of Denton – Alternate Vacancy
Board of Supervisor of Elections**

The Board of Supervisor of Elections consists of three individuals who are appointed by the Denton Town Council to oversee Town Elections. The Town Council also appoints one individual to serve as an Alternate. The Alternate is called upon to assist on Election Day, should the need arise to fill in for a regular Election Supervisor.

The Town is currently seeking letters of interest to fulfill a vacancy on the board for the Alternate Position - two-year term.

Applicant must be a qualified voter of the Town of Denton, as per Article V of the Denton Town Charter. Must be available to be present during all regular Town Elections which are held on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November and for any other Special Election that may be required.

Ordinance No. 734

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS AND ESTIMATE INCOME IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BUDGET ADOPTED FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023.

Sec. 2 Rate of Taxation on Real Property

That the rate of taxation on real property to be taxed within the boundaries of the Town of Denton, Maryland shall be and hereby is established as:

Seventy-four cents (\$0.74)

on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the value for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and including June 30, 2023

Sec. 3 Rate of Taxation on Business Personal Property

That the rate of taxation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and including June 30, 2023, on any incorporated personal property to be taxed by the Town of Denton, Maryland, shall be and hereby is established as:

One Dollar and Fifty cents (\$1.50)

on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation, unless otherwise provided for by Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

Sec. 4 Rate of Taxation on Railroad and Utility Property

That the rate of taxation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022 and including June 30, 2023 on any railroad and utility property to be taxed by the Town of Denton, Maryland, shall be and hereby is established as:

One Dollar and Seventy cents (\$1.70)

on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation, unless otherwise provided for by Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

Sec. 5 Service and Administration Fee Collected by Caroline County Tax Office

That the rate of service and administrative fees on semi-annual billings assessed by the Caroline County Tax Office shall be and is hereby established as:

.110% service and Admin Fee 2022—2023. This is computed at .4% annual interest divided by twelve months times three months, October, November & December times 1.1%.

Boat Ramp Permit Season

Boating season is here. Just a reminder, effective April 1, 2009, a permit is required to launch any vessel, via boat trailer, at all Caroline County boat ramps and public landings.

Permits may be purchased for one day use or annual use and vary in price.

A one day pass is \$10. Annual pass fees are \$25. Annual permits are valid only when displayed on the driver's

side of the boat trailer tongue, within 12 inches of the hitch. Daily permits must be hung on the inside mirror facing the windshield. Fines for a first offense are \$50, and a second offense is \$100.

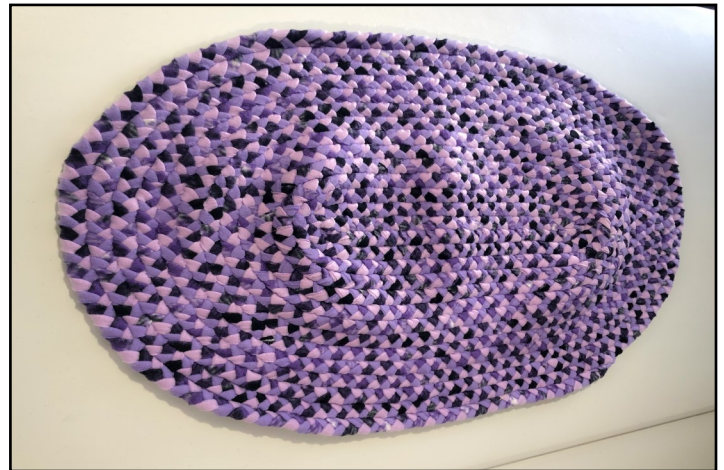

age, for every dollar that a Main Street program spent to support their operations, it generated \$19.34 of new investment back into Main Street communities.

The Downtown Denton Main Street's performance is annually evaluated by Main Street Maryland which works in partnership with Main Street America to identify the local programs that meet rigorous national performance standards. valuation criteria determines the communities that are building meaningful and sustainable revitalization programs and include standards such as, fostering strong public-private partnerships, supporting small and locally owned businesses, and actively preserving historic places, spaces, and cultural assets.

In the year of 2021 Main Street was awarded \$80,000.00 of that \$35,755.00 went directly to our small businesses to help recover from the pandemic. Other portions were used for marketing, investment in Denton Community Demonstration Garden and Artsway Pathway (our green space right in the heart of downtown), the Denton Dollar eGift Card bonus gift program. hosting numerous events that helped bring people to our downtown: May Day, Shop Small Saturday, Supper at Sunset, Christkindmarkt, Carriage Rides, Farmers

Market. We also have recorded 471 volunteer hours. We here at DDMS are proud to be an accredited Main Street since 1999! Since 1999 DDMS has put back into the community approximately \$179,000.00.

Service Fees for Utility Calls

All calls for utility service for properties located in the Town of Denton are assessed the following service fee. This fee applies for all water shut off/turned on, and other miscellaneous calls for service. Paying utility bills on time can help the property owner avoid these fees.

Special Attention: Any water that is turned off will be assessed this fee to have the water turned back on. Tenants will need to pay this fee before water service is turned back on. (This may not apply for emergency situations pending the nature of the call.)

\$100.00 fee after normal business hours.

Attention Settlement Attorneys

Reminder to all settlement attorney's and agencies to please contact the Denton Town Office for fees due to the Town when handling settlements for properties being sold or transferred within the Town limits. There may be water/sewer fees or miscellaneous charges that need to be collected at the time of settlement. This will keep the Town's records up to date and better serve the resident's of the Town of Denton. This will also eliminate problems after settlement of any outstanding balances for the new property owner.

Please note: Any property that transfers ownership and the utility fees are not collected at settlement and forwarded to the town that result in the water being turned off for non-payment, the water turn on fee will still be charged. This charged maybe passed on to the settlement attorney. Currently the fee to turn water service back on during regular business hours is \$50.00 and after 3:30 PM the fee is \$100.00.
