PROCEEDINGS

1	The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Mackel at 6:00 p.m. in the Denton Town
2	Conference Room. Pledge of Allegiance.
3	The minutes of the October 17, 2012, Historic Review Meeting were approved as submitted.
4	Old Business #1 - None.
5	New Business #1 – Funk & Bolton/Sign – Sandy Hayman made the presentation on behalf of
6	Funk & Bolton requesting approval to install signage at 300 Market Street. Projecting signage will
7	be installed on bracket in existing holes on the outside of the building.
8	Vice Chairperson Peterson motioned to approve the application as submitted for the signage
9	per the submittal.
10	Commissioner Bobbick seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
11	New Business #2 - Victor & Joann Redden/Patio & Pavers - Joann Redden made the
12	presentation requesting approval for installation of a patio and pavers at 205 Gay Street. Applicant
13	provided a picture to the Commission of proposed materials. Applicant has removed the concrete.
14	Vice Chairperson Peterson motioned to approve the patio and pavers as described in the
15	application submitted.
16	Commissioner Bobbick seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
17	New Business #3 - Shelly Sarsfield/Carport & Windows - Paul Osborne, made the
18	presentation on behalf of Shelly Sarsfield, for the proposed carport and window installation.
19	The window will replace the existing attic vent and will match existing windows.
20	The proposed carport is an open pole barn style to match the house. Carport will be
21	constructed to match the siding lines, roof, gable end, and posts on the porch.
22	Vice Chairperson Peterson motioned to approve the installation of a carport and window as
