PROCEEDINGS

Call to Order:

The Planning Commission Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Walls at 6:33 p.m.,

on April 30, 2019, at the Denton Town Office and followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Minutes:

The March 26, 2019, Planning Commission Meeting minutes were reviewed and approved

unanimously as submitted.

Old Business #1 – Other: None.

New Business #1 – Adalea Rue/Simplified Site Plan: Adalea Rue made the presentation

for the proposed permanent cosmetics studio to be located at 8 North Second Street, Suite 1.

The Applicant's services include lash extensions, microblading, waxing, and spray tans.

Microblading is an unregulated service in the state of Maryland. Per the State of Maryland

regulations, this service is not permitted in a full or limited service hair salon. No license is

required by the State of Maryland. The Applicant has received certification for this service.

Proposed signage will be placed inside the window and made of vinyl and wood.

All appointments are prescheduled, and the applicant does not accept walk-in customers.

The proposed hours of operation include Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday from Noon to 6:00 p.m.

Appointments range from one hour to two and a half hours depending on the type of service.

Chairperson Walls noted that the microblading would be classified as a tattoo parlor. This

type of service would need to be added to the Denton Town Code.

This proposed location is in the Historic District and signage can be approved

administratively.

Commissioner Mayer motioned to approve the simplified site plan for the permanent

cosmetics studio to be classified as a tattoo parlor and forward a favorable recommendation to the

Board of Appeals.

Vice Chairperson Iliff seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously (5:0).

Business #1. The Planning Commission made a favorable recommendation to forward to the

Board of Appeals.
