

Ordinance No. 763

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF DENTON REVISING THE SEWER RATES AND FEES, REVISING THE ERU TABLE, AND REVISING THE ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES ANNUALLY FOR USERS OF THE MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM FROM 2026 THROUGH 2028.

WHEREAS, Md. Code Ann. Environmental Article § 9-705 and the Denton Town Charter § C9-1 authorize the Town to construct, operate, modify and maintain a sewer system; and

WHEREAS, Md. Code Ann. Environmental Article § 9-723 through 9-726 authorize the Town to establish rates, fees and charges for municipal sewer services; and

WHEREAS, the Denton Town Council has determined that it is desirable and in the public interest to amend the sewer charges to increase capacity charges and administrative charges from 2026 to 2028 to enable the Town to meet its operation, maintenance, and debt service obligations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE DENTON TOWN COUNCIL that the following rate schedule shall apply to all users of the Denton Municipal Sewer systems:

A. **Sewer Capacity Charge.** The following capacity charge shall be assessed and paid as follows:

1. Single Family Residential property.....~~[\$5000.00]~~ **\$6,000**

~~[2. Multi Family Residential property]~~

~~[a. Efficiency/one bedroom (per unit)\$2500.00]~~

~~[b. Two or more bedrooms (per unit)\$5000.00]~~

3. All ~~[Commercial Properties]~~ **OTHER PROPERTIES**

Capacity Charge shall be determined by using TABLE 1 attached hereto. The Capacity Charge shall be a multiple of the Single-Family Residential Capacity Charge set forth above according to the number of Equivalent Residential Units (ERU) listed in Table 1 for the subject property type. An ERU is ~~[established by the Caroline County Health Department]~~ **EQUAL TO 225 GALLONS PER DAY.**

~~[4. Industrial Properties]~~

~~Capacity Charge shall be determined by using TABLE 2 attached hereto.]~~

- B. For all properties within the Denton Municipal boundaries, as defined by Ordinance No. 181, payable quarterly:

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026: Administrative Fee BASE FEE is ~~[\$50.00]~~ **\$60.50**. An additional ~~[\$8.00]~~ **\$9.68** will be assessed for each 1,000 gallons.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2027: ADMINISTRATIVE FEE BASE FEE IS \$62.92. AN ADDITIONAL \$10.07 WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH 1,000 GALLONS.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2028: ADMINISTRATIVE FEE BASE FEE IS \$65.44. AN ADDITIONAL \$10.47 WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH 1,000 GALLONS.

- C. For all properties located outside the Denton Municipal boundaries, as defined by Ordinance No. 181, or on tax waiver, payable quarterly:

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026: Administrative Fee BASE FEE is ~~[\$100.00]~~ **\$121.00**. An additional ~~[\$16.00]~~ **\$19.36** will be assessed for each 1,000 gallons.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2027: ADMINISTRATIVE FEE BASE FEE IS \$125.84. AN ADDITIONAL \$20.13 WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH 1,000 GALLONS.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2028: ADMINISTRATIVE FEE BASE FEE IS \$130.87. AN ADDITIONAL \$20.94 WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH 1,000 GALLONS.

- D. All vacant lots which have access to municipal sewer will be assessed a \$25.00 quarter availability fee.

- E. **CALLS FOR SERVICE: THE FOLLOWING FEE SHALL BE ASSESSED AND PAID AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **DURING REGULAR TOWN OFFICE HOURS50.00**
2. **ALL OTHER HOURS100.00**

The Ordinance shall be effective within (7) Seven days ~~[and begin with Oct. 1, 2023 billing cycle, and thereafter]~~ from and after the date of its final passage and adoption. Any Town resolutions or ordinances establishing rates or charges for the above listed services which are in conflict with the above established rates or charges hereby is repealed upon this ordinance's effective date.

NOTES:

- 1) In no event shall the hook-up fee for any connection be less than that established for a single-family residence.
- 2) Any user not explicitly listed above shall be determined on a case-by-case basis in accordance with guidelines then in use by the Maryland Department of Health.
- 3) Multiple uses connecting to one hook-up shall be assessed the appropriate hook-up fee for each use.
- 4) **ERU CALCULATIONS WILL BE ROUNDED TO THE NEAREST 0.5.**

Plus additional per 20,000 sq ft or fraction beyond 20,000	\$1,000.00

NOTES:

1) The hook-up fees listed for industrial users apply only to the domestic waste portion of the wastewater flow (i.e. toilets, sinks, showers, & bathtubs). Allowance of permits for any industrial use of water or sewer shall be determined on a case-by-case basis. Hook-up fees, if connection is permitted, will be determined based on the quantity of flow and characteristics of the waste determined either by analysis, or projects where analysis is not available on the basis of at least 3 similar industrial plants which employ the same process as the one in question.

2) The sprinkler fee listed above is payable at the time of connection. There will be an additional "availability" charge assessed quarterly along with the billing for system usage.]
